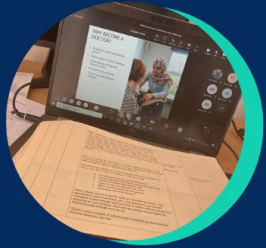

2024 entry applications

- **2 May 2023** – 2024 entry courses will be shown in our [search tool](#).
- **16 May 2023** – you can start your undergraduate application for 2024 entry courses, but you cannot submit it to UCAS until **5 September 2023**.
- **16 October 2023 for 2024 entry at 18:00 (UK time)** – deadline for any course at the universities of Oxford and Cambridge, or for most courses in medicine, veterinary medicine/science, and dentistry. You can add choices with a different deadline later, but don't forget you can only have five choices in total.
- **31 January 2024 for 2024 entry at 18:00 (UK time)** – deadline for the majority of courses.

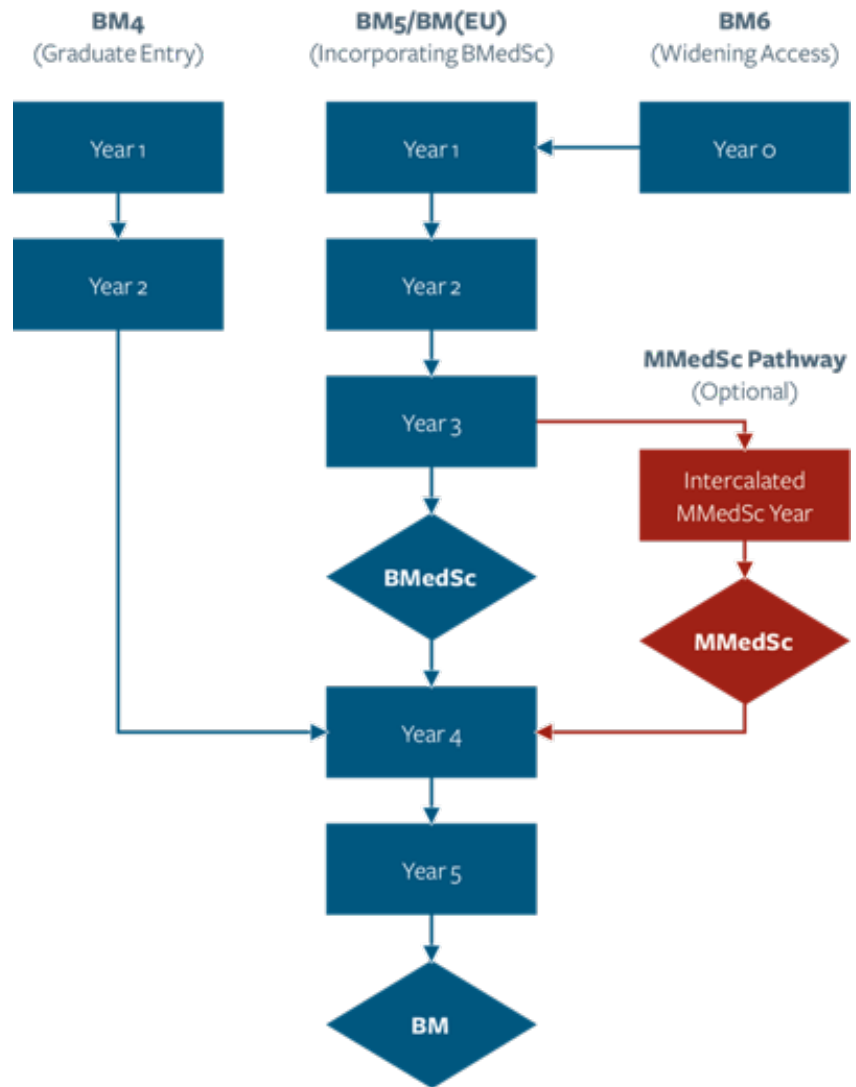

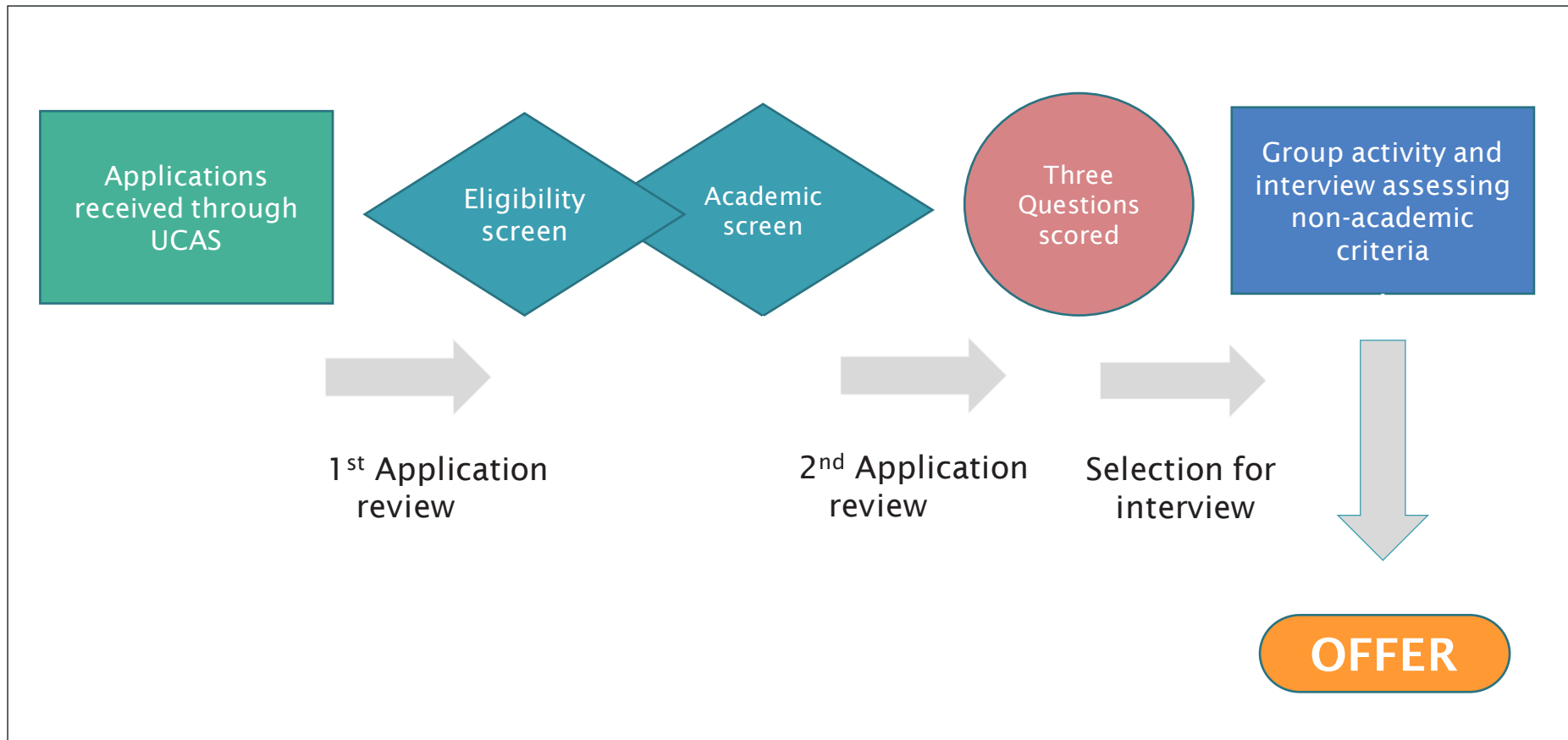

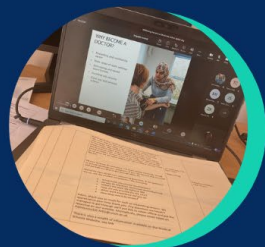
