Applying for Medicine or Dentistry?

Most UK universities require applicants to Medicine and Dentistry courses to sit an admissions test in addition to their other entry requirements. The UCAT is a two-hour, multiple choice test which assess a range of mental abilities identified by university medical and dental schools as important. The test is delivered at test centres throughout the UK and internationally.

WHEN DO I NEED TO SIT THE UCAT?

If you plan to apply to any of our consortium universities, as listed on our website, in 2023 (for entry to university in September 2024) then you will need to sit the test before 28 September 2023. You should also check individual university websites for specific entry requirements of each course.
