

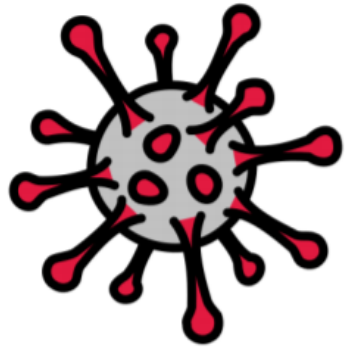

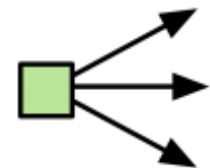


Testing for Coronavirus is going to be done for



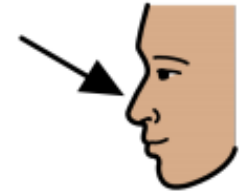

This will help find Coronavirus and stop it spreading.





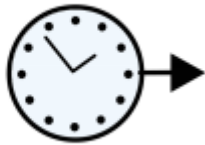
For school the test will be done with a swab.

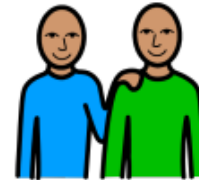

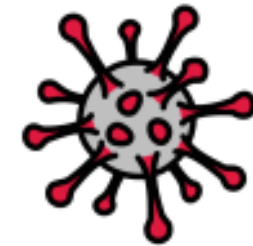

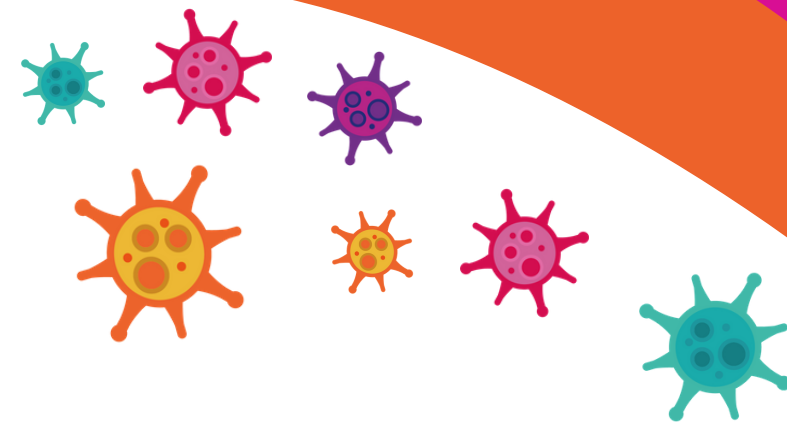
