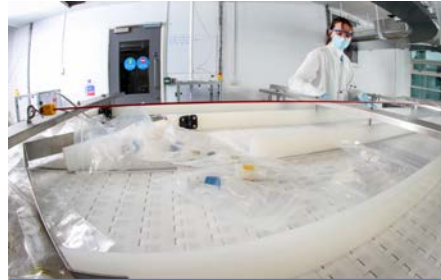

## The Testing Journey



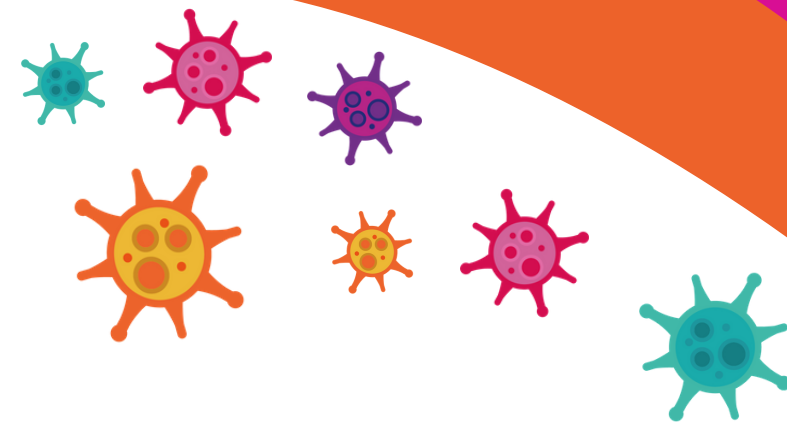
The results of the test are checked by the scientist and the results sent out to schools and parents.
